

Important Note for online payment

The Payment Card Industry Security Standards Council (PCI SSC), has issued a mandate designed to protect public (i.e. internet) communications that carry PCI-sensitive data. This would result in removal of early versions of Gateway communication protocols and encryption ciphers – TLS version 1.1 and moving to more secure encryption protocols – TLS 1.2 in order to meet the PCI Data Security Standard (PCI DSS) for the safeguarding of payment data.

Payment Gateway would be discontinuing the support for browsers that support older versions of security protocols i.e. TLS v. 1.1 from **March 25th, 2019**. This would impact the following browsers:

- 1) Microsoft Internet Explorer 10 and below
- 2) Microsoft Internet Explorer 10 running on Microsoft Windows version lower than Microsoft Windows 7 & 2008
- 3) Mozilla Firefox 27 and below Google Chrome 37 and below
- 4) Google Android OS Browser Android 4.4 (KitKat) and below
- 5) Opera Browser 16 and below
- 6) Mobile Safari for iOS 5 and below
- 7) Desktop Safari versions 7 and below for OS X 10.8 (Mountain Lion) and below

We would request you to please download the latest version of the browsers and are initiating payments from the new browsers that support TLS v1.2 onwards, else payment page will not open if redirected from our web-site from the browsers mentioned above.
