(Honours & General) courses (Under CBCS System) through the online merit-based system will be done for the session: 2020-2021. Students intending for admission into B. A./B. Sc./B. Com (Honours & General) Courses may apply on payment of Rs. 120/- (excluding bank charges, if any) through the online process.

Read and follow the undermentioned frequently asked questions and answer very carefully before submission of the online application form.

01	What are the minimum eligibility criteria for application?	<p>a) To apply for <b>Honours Courses</b>, the candidate must have got either 50 % in Subject or 45 % in aggregate (to be calculated by adding marks obtained in the five best subjects).</p> <p>b) To apply for <b>General Courses</b>, the candidate must have got pass marks in at least five subjects.</p> <p>c) Students seeking admission for <b>Honours in History, Philosophy &amp; Political Science</b> will be allowed to apply, even if they have not studied these subjects in H.S. level.</p> <p>d) Students seeking admission for <b>Honours in Economics &amp; Accountancy</b> will be allowed to apply, even if they have not studied these subjects in H.S. level but they must have Mathematics in H.S. level.</p> <p>e) Students seeking admission for <b>Honours in Computer Science</b> will be allowed to apply if they have studied Computer Science at H.S. level.</p>

		otherwise, they must have studied Mathematics in H.S. level.
02	Whether any student passed out in 2017 or before that can be eligible for application?	No student passed H.S./equivalent Examination in 2017 can be eligible for application. Only the students passed H.S. Examination in 2018, 2019 & 2020 can be eligible to apply provided that they have not appeared in any examination at graduation level under Vidyasagar University.
03	What is the Eligibility for the students passed out from other Boards and/or other Courses?	a) Students passed out from other Boards can be eligible for application. But, at the time of Counseling for those students, migration certificate or documentary evidence of having applied for migration is to be submitted & verified.  b) The students passed out from Vocational Courses are eligible to apply only in General Course.
04	How is the Merit-Point calculated in the preparation of merit list?	<b>a) For Honours Course:</b> Merit Point = Marks obtained in the Subject (or allied subject marks) for which admission in Honours is sought + 10 % of the aggregate marks in H.S.  <b>b) For General Course:</b> Merit Point = Marks obtained in aggregate in H.S. or Equivalent Courses.  N. B.: - Aggregate marks means the highest marks obtained in five subjects.
05	Whether a candidate can apply in more than one Honours Course and in General Course?	a) Yes, an applicant can apply in more than one honours subjects as per their choice in the separate application form with the payment of <b>Rs.120/-</b> for each honours Subject.  b) To apply in general courses separate application form to be filled in with the payment of <b>Rs.120/-</b> .  c) Any applicant with an application form in honours course shall not be allowed to take admission in general courses.
